Program Options:

- Regular MSW – 2 YR program** – 60 credits
- Regular MSW – 3 YR program** – 60 credits
- Advanced standing – 1 YR Program** – 30 credits – must hold BSW from CSWE accredited university within last 5 years – 3.5 GPA in Social Work courses
- Advanced standing – 2 YR Program** – 30 credits – must hold BSW from CSWE accredited university within last 5 years – 3.5 GPA in Social Work courses
- Dual MPH/MSW** – 90 credits – 3 years – must apply through Department of Public Health and School of Social Work
