

**MSW Two-Year Foundation Plus Concentration Plan**

Students selecting this plan begin their program during the fall semester and complete four semesters, graduating in spring of their second year. They complete 15 credit hours each semester for a total of 60 credit hours. Field experiences include 225 hours for two semesters for the Foundation sequence and 250 hours for two semesters for the Concentration sequence.
